- Participants must work individually, no outside help or group entries. Mobile phones or digital references are not allowed during the competition unless approved.

REGALIA REVEALED

Event Description :

Participants will come in traditional attire from cultures around the globe. They will speak about the culture and elements of culture that they have used in their attire such as colours, jewellery, or any other accessories.

Instructions:

- Each participant will research on a culture around the globe.
- Use props, clothing, cultural elements to depict the culture.
- While presenting the culture, the participant should describe the culture using various props used, clothing, food, and festivals etc. (not limited to).
- Participant should be able to discuss the significance of the culture chosen, rationale behind culture chosen, and current status of the culture chosen.
- No time will be given for preparation

Criteria:

- Appearance/aesthetics: visual appeal, design elements, suitability with the chosen culture
- Choice of elements: reflection of geographical region/local elements, origin and evolution of Regalia, influence of economic condition on materials or styles of regalia
- Presentation skills: confidence, use of visual aids/prompts, clarity and engagement.
- Cultural authenticity: accurate representation, respect for tradition
- Creativity and cultural awareness: innovative approaches and cultural significance

- The character should have clear depth and significance in the work.
- Monologue/Scene Preparation
- Prepare either:
 - An original monologue written in the voice of the character (1-3 minutes),
OR
 - A dramatic scene/soliloquy adapted directly from the text.
- Ensure your performance reflects the character's personality, emotions, and context in the story.
- Props and costume may be used but should remain minimal and supportive (not the main focus)
- Voice projection, body language, and facial expression are key to bringing the character alive.

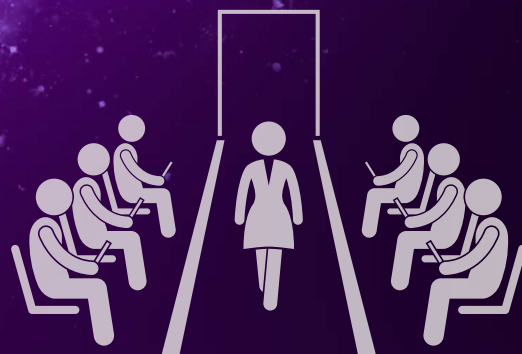

Event Description:

Inspire creativity and imagination by crafting costumes that highlight the journey beyond the stars.

Instructions:

- Create a creative, space-themed outfit inspired by planets, stars, galaxies, astronauts, rockets, aliens, constellations, or space exploration.
- Participants are encouraged to incorporate recycled, reflective, metallic, fluorescent, neon, LED, or glow-in-the-dark materials. The event may take place under dim lighting or blacklight.
- Outfits must be ready before the event and should be safe, comfortable, wearable, and suitable for walking on stage.
- Each participant/group will present their outfit through a stage walk, followed by a 1-2 minute explanation covering:
 - Inspiration behind the design
 - Space element or concept represented
 - Materials used
 - One interesting fact about the chosen theme
- Lightweight and safe props or accessories may be used, such as astronaut helmets, rocket packs, galaxy masks, star wands, or constellation-themed elements. They must be easy to carry.

- Participants will be judged only on the basis of their performance.
- Post production tracks are not allowed (auto tune/delay/ reverb/echo etc)
- Recorded voices/backing vocals cannot be used in the backing tracks.
- No profanity or inappropriate words/themes to be used in songs performed.

THE VIEW WITHIN PHOTOGRAPHY

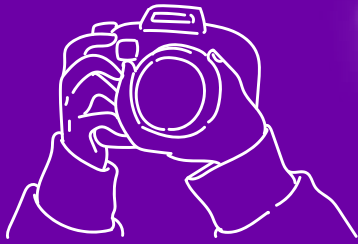
Event Description:

- Participants must bring their own cameras/DSLRs/digital camera/mirrorless cameras/laptops.
- Theme will be announced at the venue just before the competition begins.
- Each participant should submit only SIX photographs with a 4-5 line description about the idea/emotion/story/ creative intention behind the photograph.
- Basic editing (cropping, brightness, contrast, color correction, minor exposure adjustments) is allowed, but heavy editing/filters/AI generated content/compositing are not permitted.
- All photographs must be clicked within the school premises during the competition time.
- All photographs must be original and captured by the participant during the competition while respecting the privacy and dignity of people photographed and obtain appropriate permission before hand.
- Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Every submitted photograph must include the following:
Participant's name, school name, grade, image title, date, shutter speed, aperture, ISO

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THE VIEW WITHIN PHOTOGRAPHY

Criteria: Originality and authenticity

For each submitted photograph, participants must write 4-5 lines answering the following questions:

- What is happening in the photograph?
- What emotion/idea are you trying to communicate?
- How did you use light, composition, colour, expression and perspective?
- Why did you choose this particular moment?
- What makes the photograph unique or meaningful?

Topic- "Beyond the Face: A Portrait of Emotion"

All six photographs must have this description.

Event Description:

ONLINE EVENT

Event Description:

Web Weavers is a website development challenge that requires participants to design and develop a functional website using HTML, CSS, and JavaScript only. The theme for the website will be announced at the beginning of the event. Possible themes may include Environment, Education, Social Causes, Entrepreneurship, or other relevant topics.

Task:

Participants must design and develop a website based on the theme announced at the start of the event. The website should demonstrate functionality, creativity, effective design, and a clear connection to the given theme.

Tools: HTML, CSS, JavaScript (No other programming languages or frameworks may be used.)

Student will join the online meeting and complete development in their laptop and upload in given link. Teams must submit both the design (hand drawn UI/UX) and full code, image etc of the website. Each team must also make a 3-5 min video explaining features, coding complexity and design choices. A template will be provided to do the documentation.

Instructions

1. Participants will join the designated online meeting at the scheduled time.
2. The website must be developed entirely during the 2-hour event period.
3. Participants must submit the following:
 - A hand-drawn UI/UX design or wireframe of the website.
 - Complete source code.
 - All images and other assets used in the website.
 - Completed event documentation using the provided template.
 - A 3-5 minute video presentation explaining the website's features, coding complexity, design choices, and overall concept.
4. All content, images, graphics, and other external resources used must be properly cited.
5. Participants must ensure that their work is original and independently developed.
6. The use of AI tools or AI-generated content is strictly prohibited. Any submission found to have used AI assistance may be disqualified.

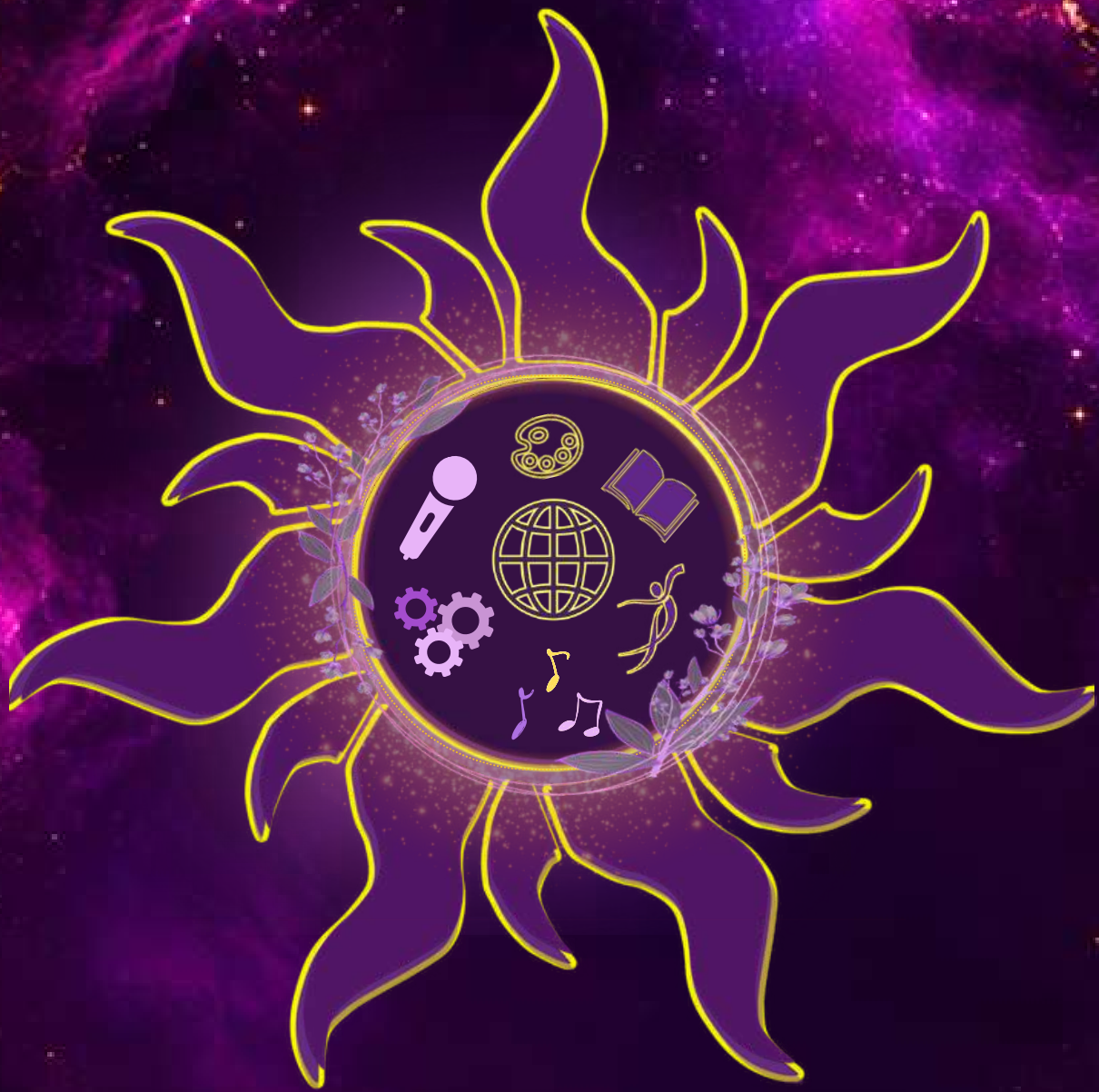
